EXPLORE YOUR PATH IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE AT WESTERN NEW ENGLAND UNIVERSITY

Enrollment in the Criminal Justice program at Western New England University has increased significantly since 2019-2020. The program offers a variety of concentrations and courses to help students explore their path in criminal justice.

These enhancements include:

- Four concentrations: Criminal Justice, Corrections, Law Enforcement, and Security & Investigations
- Fewer required courses (34 total, 24 core courses)
- An increased number of 300 and 400 level course offerings (8 new courses, including Criminal Justice, Corrections, Law Enforcement, Security & Investigations, and Criminal Justice & Corrections)

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Students can explore various career paths in criminal justice, including law enforcement, corrections, and security.

INTERNSHIPS AND FIELD WORK

Students can gain valuable experience through internships and field work, providing hands-on learning in the criminal justice field.

Students can learn from faculty experts in criminal justice, including those with advanced degrees (P.D., J.D., M.A., M.S., M.P.L., S.A.P.L.) and extensive professional experience.
