The following Berkshire Community College courses will count as satisfying Western New England University's general University requirements: PSY 107 Intro. to Psychology or SOC 105 Intro. to Sociology ; Any (HIS) History course (one); Any (two) BIO 101, BIO 102, CHM 101, CHM 102.

\* Business courses from a college not accredited by AACSB that are determined to be equivalent to 300-400 level courses at Western New England University will be considered for transfer credit (up to 2 courses).

All course recommendations are for the below business majors: Accounting, Business Analytics and Information Management, Finance, General Business, Human Resource Management, Management & Leadership, Marketing, Marketing Communications/Advertising, Sport Management.

Business Analytics & Information Management - In order to complete the Business Analytics and Information Management degree at WNE in two additional years, students must take BAIM 221 - Statistics for Business Analytics at WNE prior to enrolling at WNE. Without this course it will take an additional year to complete this program.
