- Must have compelling academic or medical reasons, such as a change of major or research topic, unexpected research problems or documented illnesses, etc.

Reasons to DENY an I-20 extension request:

- Taking additional courses beyond those required for program completion
- Insufficient academic progress
- Accommodating on- or off-campus employment opportunities (i.e. full-time CPT or OPT, or to adjust when you can start/end OPT)
